

Samsung Canada “Solve for Tomorrow” 2024/2025 Education Contest OFFICIAL RULES

THE CONTEST IS SPONSORED BY SAMSUNG ELECTRONICS CANADA INC. (“SPONSOR”): 2050 DERRY ROAD WEST, MISSISSAUGA, ON, L5N 0B9.

No purchase necessary to enter or win. Void where prohibited. The Samsung Canada “Solve for Tomorrow” 2024/2025 Education Contest (the “Contest”) will run in accordance with these Rules. The Sponsor reserves the right, subject to any required approval of any regulatory authorities, to cancel, amend, modify or terminate this Contest or these Official Rules at any time in its sole discretion and without further notice. Changes to these rules will be posted online at www.samsung.com/ca/solve. You must comply with these Official Rules and you will be deemed to have received, understood and agreed to these Official Rules if you participate in the Contest.

1. Entry Date:

The Contest entry period begins at 12:00:01 a.m. Eastern Standard Time (“EST”) on Tuesday, October 15, 2024 and ends at 11:59:59 p.m. EST on Friday, December 20, 2024 (“Contest Entry Period”). The Contest will be divided into three (3) phases, as outlined below.

2. Eligibility:

The Contest is open only to legal residents of Canada who are twenty one (21) years of age or older and are currently employed as full-time teachers in a public Middle School, Junior High School, or High School, grades 6-12, including Charter Schools that are 50% or more publicly funded in Canada. All Canadian publicly funded schools are eligible to participate. Schools that are publicly funded but outside of the provincially-run school board/district/division system, such as Charter Schools in Alberta and Federally-funded schools in FNMI communities, are eligible to apply if they meet the grade requirements. Home School, privately funded Charter school (less than 50% publicly funded), Private School, College, University, and Vocational/Trade School teachers are not eligible to participate. A full-time teacher, as defined above, is eligible to enter the Contest as part of a team with at least one (1) or more students, up to a maximum of fifty (50) students (the “Participant”). Employees of the Sponsor, not-for-profit organizations that are supporting the Sponsor with the promotion, and each of their respective parents, affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising and promotion agencies, retailers, distributors and suppliers (collectively the “Contest Entities”), and the immediate families (spouse, parents, children and siblings and their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside) and individuals living in the same households of any of the foregoing individuals, whether or not related, are ineligible to participate or win a prize. The Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial and local laws and regulations.

3. General Conditions

ENTRY NOTE: Participants are responsible for confirming whether their school has any policies or restrictions concerning participation in contests such as this. The awarding of prizes is subject to such school policies. If, for any reason, any school is unable to accept a prize, including due to school policies, such prize will be forfeited and Sponsor will not have any further obligation to such school. Prizes will be awarded to the school for the benefit of the teacher submitting the entry for its respective Participant.

PRIZE NOTE: All prizes will be awarded to the winning schools and not the Participant. Winning schools will be responsible for all taxes, if any (including federal, provincial and local taxes) and other costs and expenses associated with the acceptance and use of a prize (or any portion thereof) not included with the prize as awarded, including, but not limited to, installation and costs of any service, including any telephone or cable service.

All prizes awarded pursuant to this Contest are awarded “as is” with no warranty or guarantee, either express or implied, by Sponsor except for any manufacturer’s warranty accompanying the Samsung products. Selected contestants/finalists/winners may not substitute, assign or transfer prize or redeem prize for cash, but Sponsor reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to substitute the prize (or any portion thereof) with one of comparable or greater value. Prizes will be awarded to the selected contestants/finalists/winners’ school for the benefit of the applicable selected contestants/finalists/winners. Selected contestants/finalists/winners will be responsible for any expenses associated with acceptance and use of the prize except as expressly stated in these Official Rules. All prize details are at the sole discretion of the Sponsor.

Notwithstanding anything contained herein, Sponsor reserves the right to not award all prizes or advance fewer entries for any phase of the Contest if, in its sole discretion, it determines it has not received a sufficient number of qualified eligible entries.

IF YOU ARE A SELECTED CONTESTANT/FINALIST/WINNER, YOU MUST, BEFORE BEING DECLARED A WINNER: (i) correctly answer, without assistance of any kind, whether mechanical or otherwise, a mathematical skill testing question; and (ii) in the Sponsor’s sole discretion, execute and deliver to the Sponsor within the time specified by the Sponsor the School Liability and Publicity Release (the Waiver), Teacher Affidavit, Parent Guardian Permission Form, and Adult Release in a form acceptable to the Contest Sponsor, confirming your compliance with these Rules, acceptance of the applicable prize as awarded without substitution, and releasing the Sponsor, its affiliates and related third parties, advertising and promotional agencies, and each of their respective shareholders, directors, officers, employees, agents, dealers, representatives, successors and assigns (collectively the “Released Parties”) from any liability in connection with this Contest, your participation therein and/or the awarding and use/misuse of the applicable prize or any portion thereof. All required documents must be executed and returned prior to receiving a prize.

3. Phase One: Regional Finalists

A) Phase One Entry Submission:

You may enter the Contest by visiting www.samsung.com/ca/solve during the Contest Entry Period and following the directions to complete and submit the Official Entry Form (collectively, the “Entry”).

B) Entry Form Questions:

This Contest focuses on how Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (“STEM”) can be applied to help support sustainability, health, and/or underrepresented groups in your local or national community (the “Project”). The Contest Participants will be required to answer the following questions to enter into the Contest:

- What is the local community challenge that your students have identified within one of

the three entry categories below? (100 words min)

- Sustainability
- Health
- Underrepresented Groups
- What is your students' proposed STEM solution to the challenge that they have identified? (100 words min)
- How will your students' STEM solution be sustainable and successful? (100 words min)

Your answers to the above questions will be judged in accordance with the specifications set out below to determine which Participants will advance to Phase Two of the Contest. Answers to each question must not exceed two hundred (200) words. All Phase One entries must be received by 11:59:59 p.m. EST on Friday, December 20, 2024 to be considered. Entries will only be accepted in English or French, answers to all questions must be in the form of a statement, and only fully completed entries will be accepted and eligible for entry into the Contest. Answers submitted in other forms such as poems or songs will not be considered. The decisions of the judges are final and legally binding in all matters relating to this Contest. Entries generated by script, macro or other automated means and entries by any other means which subvert the entry process or are otherwise not in compliance with these Official Rules are void. Limit one (1) entry per school e-mail address during Phase One; however, more than one teacher from the same school may enter. If multiple Entries are received from the same person utilizing multiple email addresses, the judges may use their discretion to select the entry submission and or disqualify the Participant from participation in this Contest. Proof of submitting an entry does not constitute proof of delivery. Entries that are in any way fraudulent, illegible, altered, mutilated or tampered with, in the sole discretion of the Sponsor, will be declared invalid. All entries become the property of the Sponsor and will not be acknowledged or returned. The responses to the questions must never have been previously exhibited publicly outside of this Contest or selected as a winner in any other contest. Entry must be Participant's own original work, be true and verifiable, cannot be previously published or submitted in connection with any other, program or contest, may not be offensive or inappropriate and may not contain profanities or obscenities nor depict Contest Entities unfavorably, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. Entries must be consistent with the images of the Contest Entities and must not defame or invade publicity rights or privacy of any person, living or deceased, or otherwise infringe upon any person's personal or property rights or any other third party rights. Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any entry it determines does not comply with these requirements or these Official Rules, in its sole discretion.

BY SUBMITTING AN ENTRY, YOU AGREE THAT THE INFORMATION IN YOUR RESPONSES COMPLIES WITH ALL CONDITIONS STATED IN THESE OFFICIAL RULES. THE RELEASED PARTIES (AS DEFINED BELOW) WILL BEAR NO LEGAL LIABILITY, EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED, REGARDING THE USE OF THE INFORMATION BY THE SPONSOR. THE RELEASED PARTIES SHALL BE HELD HARMLESS BY YOU IN THE EVENT IT IS SUBSEQUENTLY DISCOVERED THAT YOU HAVE DEPARTED FROM OR NOT FULLY COMPLIED WITH ANY OF THE OFFICIAL RULES.

C) Phase One Judging and Judging Criteria:

All eligible entries received during the Contest Entry Period will be judged based on the criteria set out below by a panel of qualified judges selected by Sponsor. The judging panel will consist of six (6) judges who will be both Sponsor judges and qualified individuals of Sponsor's partners as chosen by the Sponsor. Entries will be saved as a PDF and sent electronically to all judges and

graded individually by each judge at their place of residence in accordance with a scorecard provided by the Sponsor that contains the criteria set out below. Judging will begin Thursday, January 2, 2024 at 09:00:00 am EST and will conclude on Thursday, January 16, 2024 at 11:59:59 pm EST and be based on the following criteria:

- 45% Quality of content and adherence to theme/questions
- 45% Inclusion of specific points and/or examples illustrating the answer
- 10% Writing style and grammar

Subject to verification of eligibility and compliance with these Official Rules, twelve (12) entries with the highest scores will be deemed regional finalists (the "Regional Finalists") and will advance to Phase Two (see section 4 for Phase Two details), subject to verification of eligibility and compliance with these Rules. In the event of a tie, a "tie-breaking" judge will determine the last entrant(s) who will proceed to Phase Two based on the above stated criteria. The four regions ("Regions") are as follows:

1. BC and Northern Canada: British Columbia, Yukon, Northwest Territories, and Nunavut
2. Prairies : Alberta, Saskatchewan, and Manitoba
3. Central Canada: Ontario and Quebec
4. Atlantic Canada: New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island, and Newfoundland and Labrador

D) Phase One Notification: Regional Finalists

Each potential Regional Finalist will be notified by the Sponsor by telephone and/or e-mail on or about Monday, January 20, 2024 and will have three (3) business days to respond to such notification by e-mail. If any e-mail to a potential Regional Finalist or their school principal or other authorized officer is undeliverable, any phone number provided by a potential Regional Finalist is incorrect or no longer in service, a response to any given e-mail or phone call is not received within three (3) business days of the date of its issuance or any potential Regional Finalist school does not comply with these Official Rules, the opportunity to participate in the Contest may be forfeited and, at Sponsor's discretion, an alternate Regional Finalist may be selected.

E) Phase One Prizing: Regional Finalists

There are a total of twelve (12) Regional Finalist prizes (each a "Regional Finalist Prize") available to be won, with each Regional Finalist Prize consisting of a Samsung Voucher to purchase Samsung technology, and/or select Samsung products (as determined by Sponsor), with a combined total value of \$2,500 per potential Regional Finalist Prize.

4. Phase Two: National Finalists

A) Phase Two Video Entry Submissions:

Each Regional Finalist will be required to produce and submit one (1) video of up to five (5) minutes in length, demonstrating how STEM can be applied to help address the issue raised by the Participant in Phase One. Video submissions should also include any learnings, improvements, and lessons from the submission in Phase One.

Upon receipt of all completed documents (including: the School Liability and Publicity Release

(the Waiver), Teacher Affidavit, Parent Guardian Permission Form, and Adult Release, as required by Sponsor in its sole discretion) by the Sponsor from each Regional Finalist, the Sponsor will direct the Regional Finalist to upload the video to a password-protected website and to provide the Sponsor with the URL through which to access the video. Video must be uploaded in the period between Thursday, January 30, 2025 at 12:00:01 a.m. EST and Friday, February 28, 2025 at 11:59:59 p.m. EST to be eligible for Phase Two.

Each video must be narrated in English or French and must not exceed five (5) minutes in length. Each video must respect the size and content restrictions set out by the password-protected website to which the Participant uploads their submission. Limit one (1) video submission per Finalist. Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify any video submission if not compliant with these Official Rules or any other guidelines provided by Sponsor, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. Any student depicted in a video must have submitted a Parent Guardian Permission Form by Friday, February 28, 2025 at 11:59:59 p.m. In the event a student who has not submitted a Parent Guardian Permission Form is depicted in a video, the video in question will be disqualified. All video submissions become the property of the Sponsor and will not be returned.

B) Requirements of Video Submission:

Video submissions may not contain, as determined by the Sponsor, in its sole discretion, any content that:

- Is sexually explicit or suggestive; unnecessarily violent or derogatory of any ethnic, racial, gender, orientation, identity, religious, professional or age group; profane or pornographic; contains nudity;
- Promotes alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco, firearms/weapons (or the use of any of the foregoing); promotes any activities that may appear unsafe or dangerous; promotes any particular political agenda or message;
- Is obscene or offensive; endorses any form of hate or hate group; appears to duplicate any other video submission;
- Defames, misrepresents or contains disparaging remarks about other people or companies;
- Contains trademarks, logos, or trade dress (such as distinctive packaging or building exteriors/interiors) owned by others;
- Contains any personal identification, such as but not limited to personal names or e-mail addresses;
- Contains copyrighted materials owned by others (including music, photographs, sculptures, paintings, and other works of art or images published on or in websites, television, movies or other media);
- Contains materials embodying the names, likenesses, voices, or other indicia identifying any person, including, without limitation, celebrities and/or other public or private figures, living or dead, without permission;
- Contains look-alikes of celebrities or other public or private figures, living or dead;
- Communicates messages or images inconsistent with the positive images and/or good will to which we wish to associate; and/or
- Violates any law.

Video submissions must be the original work of the Regional Finalist and eligible students, may

not have been previously published, and may not have won previous awards or selected as a winner in any other contest. If the Entry contains any individuals other than the Regional Finalist and eligible students, the Regional Finalist is responsible for obtaining, prior to submission of the video, any and all releases and consents necessary to permit the use and exhibition of the video by Sponsor in the manner set forth in these Official Rules, including, without limitation, name and likeness permissions from any person who appears in or is identifiable in the video. Sponsor reserves the right to request proof of these permissions in a form acceptable to Sponsor from any Regional Finalist at any time. Failure to provide such proof may render such Entry disqualified from the Contest. By submitting a video, each Regional Finalist warrants and represents that they and any persons appearing or who are identifiable in the video consent to the submission and use of the video in the Contest and to its use as set forth herein.

By submitting a video, each Regional Finalist understands and agrees that the video submission may be posted on www.samsung.com/ca/solve and Samsung social media accounts, and Finalists agree that they will not use the video for any other purpose, including, without limitation, posting the video to any online social networks, without the express consent of Sponsor in each instance. Released Parties (as defined above) do not guarantee the posting of any video and are not liable for the use of any video by any third party. You acknowledge and agree that the Released Parties do not now or in the future have any duty or liability, direct or indirect, vicarious, contributory or otherwise, with respect to the infringement or protection of any copyright in and to any video submission. By entering, Participant unconditionally assigns and transfers to Sponsor all rights, title, interest and claim, which it now has or may in the future have to his/her Entry and any element(s) embodied therein. Sponsor and its designees shall have the right to edit, publish, use, adapt, reproduce, exploit, modify or dispose of any Entry and all elements of such Entry, online, in print, film, television, or in any other media now or hereafter known throughout the world.

Each eligible video submitted will be judged based on the criteria set out below to determine which entry or entries will be chosen a winner.

THE RELEASED PARTIES SHALL BE HELD HARMLESS BY YOU IN THE EVENT IT IS SUBSEQUENTLY DISCOVERED THAT YOU HAVE DEPARTED FROM OR NOT FULLY COMPLIED WITH ANY OF THE OFFICIAL RULES.

C) Phase Two Judging and Judging Criteria:

All eligible video submissions received, will be judged on the criteria set out below by a panel of qualified judges selected by Sponsor. The judging panel will consist of six (6) judges who will be both Sponsor judges and qualified individuals of Sponsor's partners as chosen by the Sponsor. Entries will be and graded individually by each judge in accordance with a scorecard provided by the Sponsor that contains the criteria set out below. Judging will begin Monday, March 3, 2025 at 09:00am EST and will conclude on Monday, March 17, 2025 at 11:59pm EST.

- 40% The submission addresses/answers the topic provided
- 40% The submission demonstrates students were actively engaged in Project
- 20% Quality of content/production of submission

Judges will select four (4) winners (each a “National Finalist”) – first, second, third, and fourth place, based on the highest scores tallied on each scorecard. In the event of a tie, a “tie-breaking” judge, to be selected by Sponsor, will determine the National Finalists based on the above stated criteria.

D) Phase Two Notification: National Finalists

The four National Finalists will be notified by the Sponsor by telephone and/or e-mail on or about Friday, March 21, 2025, and will have three (3) business days to respond to such notification by e-mail. If any e-mail to a potential National Finalist or their school principal or other authorized officer is undeliverable, any phone number provided by a potential National Finalist is incorrect or no longer in service, a response to any given e-mail or phone call is not received within three (3) business days of the date of its issuance or any potential National Finalist school does not comply with these Official Rules, the opportunity to participate in the Contest may be forfeited and, at Sponsor’s discretion, an alternate National Finalist may be selected in accordance with the Phase Two Judging and Judging Criteria set out above.

D) Phase Two Prizing: National Finalists

There are a total of four (4) National Finalist prizes (each a “National Finalist Prize”) available to be won, with each National Finalist Prize consisting of a Samsung Voucher to purchase Samsung technology, and/or select Samsung products (as determined by Sponsor), with a combined total value of \$5,000 per potential National Finalist Prize.

5. Phase Three: Grand Prize Winner and Runner Up Winners

A) Phase Three Entry Submissions:

For Phase Three, National Finalists will make a presentation to a panel of judges on their Project based on the criteria provided by Sponsor (the “Presentation”). The Presentation shall be no more than five (5) minutes in length and will proceed virtually via an online conferencing platform. National Finalists will also be required to reserve an additional five (5) minutes to answer questions from judges. The Presentation will take place on or about April 14, 2025 between 09:00:00 am EST and 11:59:59 pm EST.

B) Phase Three Judging and Judging Criteria:

All eligible entries will be judged based on the criteria set out below by a panel of qualified judges selected by Sponsor. The judging panel will consist of six (6) judges who will be both Sponsor judges and qualified individuals of Sponsor’s partners as chosen by the Sponsor. Entries will be evaluated as each National Finalist presents, and will be graded individually by each judge in accordance with a scorecard provided by the Sponsor that contains the criteria set out below. Judging will be based on the following criteria:

- 40% Originality & Feasibility
- 40% Solution Applies STEM
- 20% Quality of Presentation

Judges will select one winner (the “Grand Prize Winner”) based on the highest scores tallied on the scorecards. They will also select a second and third place winner (each a “Runner Up Winner”) based on the next highest scores tallied on the scorecards. In the event of a tie, a “tie-breaking” judge, to be selected by Sponsor, will determine the Grand Prize Winner and/or Runner Up Winners, as applicable, based on the above stated criteria. Judging will begin on or

about April 14, 2025 at 09:00:00 am EST and will conclude on or about April 14, 2025 at 11:59:59 pm EST.

C) Phase Three Notification: Grand Prize Winner

The Grand Prize Winner and Runner Up Winners will be notified by the Sponsor by email on or about Wednesday, April 30, 2025, and will have three (3) business days to respond to such notification by e-mail. If any e-mail to a potential Grand Prize Winner, Runner Up Winner, or their school principal or other authorized officer is undeliverable, any phone number provided by a potential Grand Prize Winner or Runner Up Winner is incorrect or no longer in service, a response to any given e-mail or phone call is not received within three (3) business days of the date of its issuance or any potential Grand Prize Winner or Runner Up Winner school does not comply with these Official Rules, the opportunity to participate in the Contest may be forfeited and, at Sponsor's discretion, an alternate Grand Prize Winner and/or Runner Up Winner(s) may be selected in accordance with the Phase Three Judging and Judging Criteria set out above.

D) Phase Three Prizing:

There are three (3) prizes available to be won at this phase of the Contest:

- First Place, available to be awarded to the Grand Prize Winner, consisting of (i) Samsung Vouchers to purchase Samsung technology, and/or select Samsung products (as determined by Sponsor) with a combined total value of \$50,000, and (ii) receipt of the title 2024/2025 School of Tomorrow.
- Second Place, available to be awarded to the second place Runner Up Winner, consisting of Samsung Vouchers to purchase Samsung technology, and/or select Samsung products (as determined by Sponsor), with a combined total value of \$10,000.
- Third Place, available to be awarded to the third place Runner Up Winner, consisting of Samsung Vouchers to purchase Samsung technology, and/or select Samsung products (as determined by Sponsor), with a combined total value of \$10,000.

E) Phase Three Public Voting Prizing: Solve for Tomorrow Fan Favourite Award

All four (4) National Finalists' videos from Phase Three will be displayed online at www.samsung.com/ca/solve through an embedded link to YouTube, and will participate in the Public Voting process to determine the Solve for Tomorrow Fan Favourite Winner (the "Fan Favourite Winner"). Once they have watched the National Finalists' videos, an eligible voter (defined below) can place their vote directly on www.samsung.com/ca/solve. Public Voting will begin on or around 12:01:01 a.m. EST Tuesday, April 1, 2025 and end at 11:59:59 p.m. EST on, Wednesday, April 16, 2025 ("Public Voting Period"). The Fan Favourite Winner will be announced on or before May 31, 2025.

A) Social Media Voting – Eligible Voters and Process

To participate in the Public Voting process, you must be a legal resident of Canada and thirteen years of age or older. LIMIT: One (1) vote per person per calendar day (defined as 12:00:01 a.m. EST to 11:59:59 p.m. EST (a "Calendar Day")).

All voting **must originate** at www.samsung.com/ca/solve during the Public Voting Period, and must satisfy the follow criteria:

- To register your vote, click the voting button on the Samsung Solve for Tomorrow website once a day.
- Use of automatic voting software, artificial intelligence (AI), multiple email addresses or handles to vote multiple times per day, and/or activity deemed by the Sponsor to be contrary to the spirit of fair play as it relates to the Contest and public voting is strictly prohibited.
- Sponsor will monitor all votes and has the right and at its sole discretion to disqualify votes for any of the following reasons:
 - Exceeding a maximum of one (1) vote within one Calendar Day (EST);
 - Inappropriate content;
 - Trolling or spamming other contestants; or
 - Any other behaviour as determined by the Sponsor to be a violation of the spirit of fair play as it relates to the Contest.
- Only full and complete vote entries from www.samsung.com/ca/solve will be counted.

Any posts made pursuant to the Public Voting or during the Public Voting Period, by either a voter or National Finalist, may not be offensive or inappropriate and may not contain profanities or obscenities nor depict Contest Entities unfavorably, as determined by Sponsor, in its sole discretion. Public Voting must be consistent with the images of the Contest Entities and must not defame or invade publicity rights or privacy of any person, living or deceased, or otherwise infringe upon any person's personal or property rights or any other third party rights. Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any voter or Public Voting it determines does not comply with these requirements or these Official Rules, in its sole discretion.

During the Public Voting Period, legal residents of Canada age thirteen (13) and older, will be asked to vote for the entry that best exemplifies the Phase Three video topic (i.e., demonstrate how STEM can be applied to help sustainability, health, and/or underrepresented groups in your local or national community) from among those posted. **Voting will solely determine the Solve for Tomorrow Fan Favourite Winner.** National Finalists are prohibited from obtaining votes by any fraudulent or inappropriate means, including, without limitation, offering prizes, forced voting sessions, multiple email or other inducements to members of the public, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. Use of script, macro artificial intelligence (AI), or any automated system to vote or with the intent to impair the integrity of the voting process is prohibited and all such votes will be void.

B) Solve for Tomorrow Fan Favourite Winner Selection Criteria

The National Finalist with the most public votes at the end of the Public Voting Period, will be eligible to be declared the Fan Favourite Winner. In the event of a tie, a “tie-breaking” judge, to be selected by Sponsor, will determine the potential Fan Favourite Winner.

C) Solve for Tomorrow Fan Favourite Notification

The Fan Favourite Winner will be publicly announced on or about April 30, 2025.

Notwithstanding the above, the Fan Favourite Winner will be notified by the Sponsor by email on or about Wednesday, April 30, 2025, and will have three (3) business days to respond to such notification by e-mail. If any e-mail to a potential Fan Favourite Winner, or their school principal or other authorized officer is undeliverable, any phone number provided by a potential Fan
